In order to receive payments via Paypal in Dotpay, Paypal account has to be properly configured. Necessary steps have been described below.

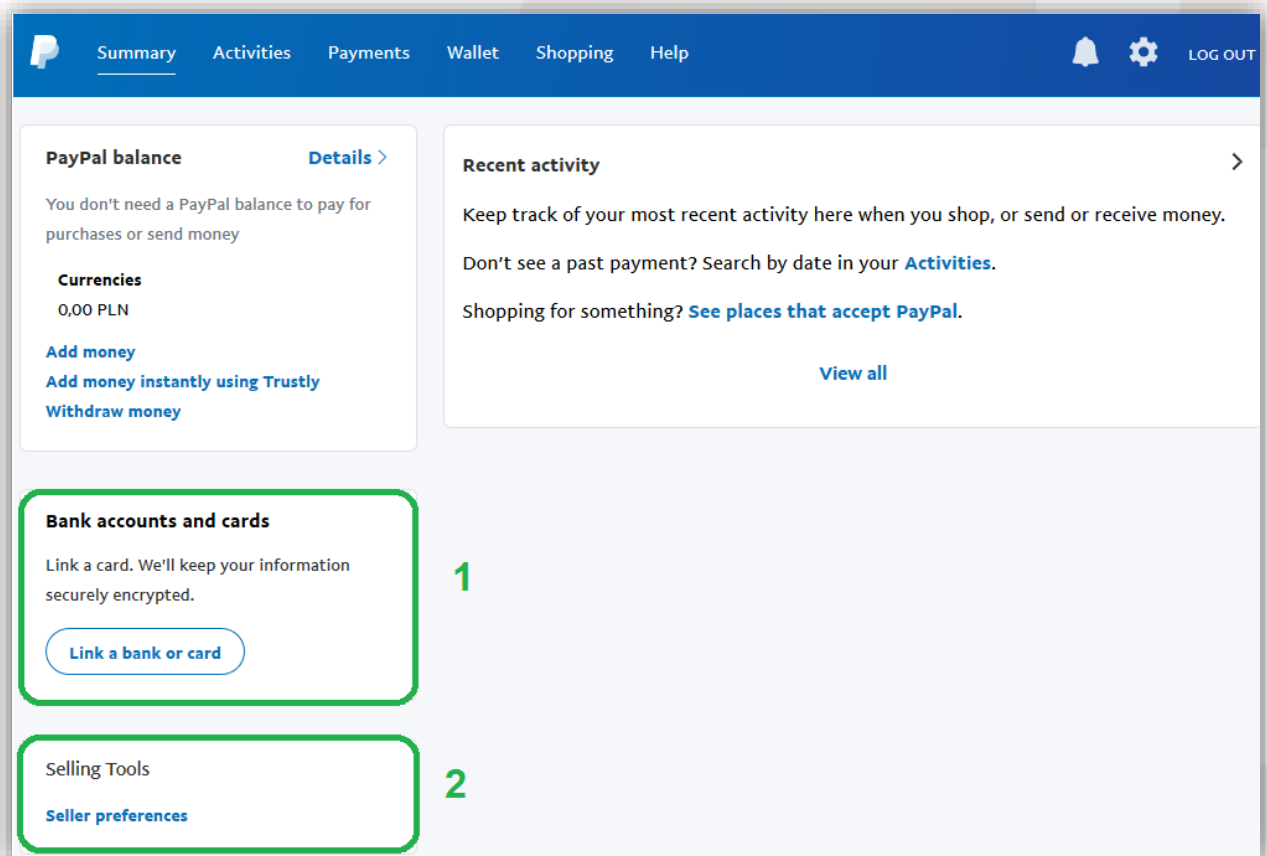
### I.1. Linking bank account

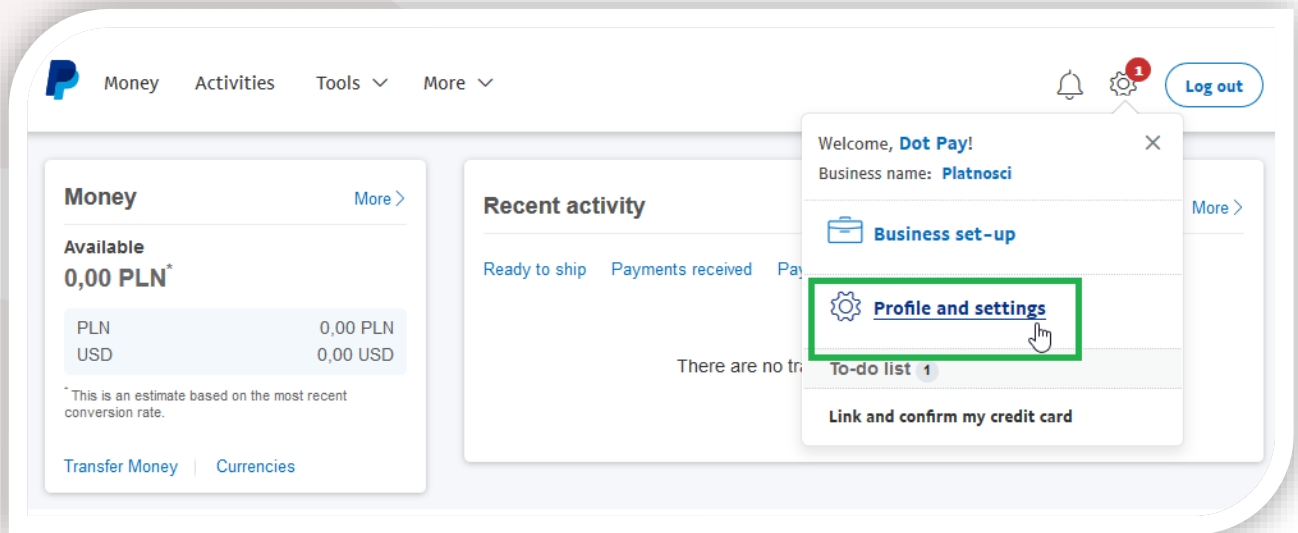

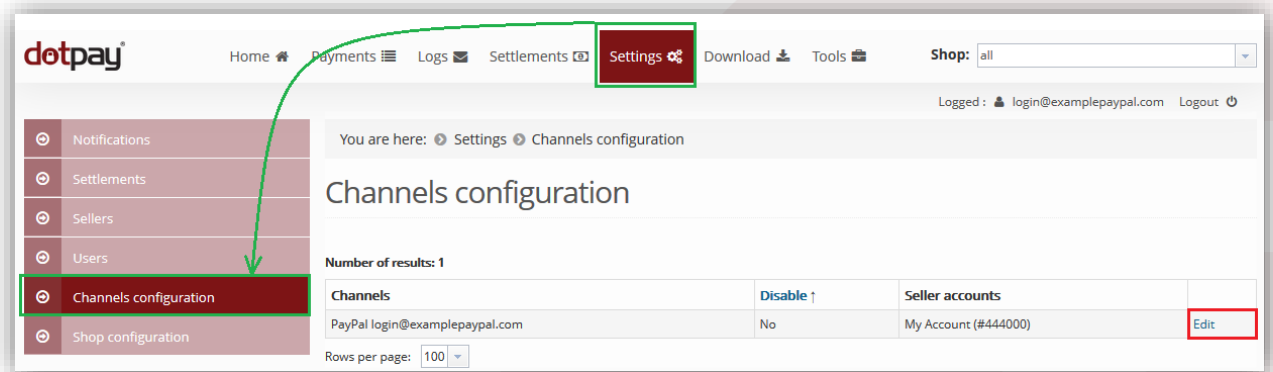
